RULES & REGULATIONS OVERVIEW

SHOW RULES

- **JUDGING:** Judging will be based on the desirable breed characteristics developed by the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA) & International Texas Longhorn Association (ITLA) and adopted by Texas Longhorns Australia.
- **SHOWMANSHIP AWARD:** To be awarded to an exhibitor of any age who shows professionalism in the way they present their cattle, themselves and handle their animals both inside and outside of the ring.
- **MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR:** To be awarded to the exhibitor who has the most success with their animals throughout the show. 1st place = 3 points, 2nd place = 2 points, 3rd place = 1 point, Champion = 5 points and supreme = 10 points.
- **BEST PRESENTED EXHIBIT:** To be selected by the official judge based on how well presented the animal is including cleanliness, coat, preparation and presentation of your animal.
- **SHOW LIST:** The TLA National Show secretary will prepare and publish a list of entries including each animal by class, entry number, name, TLA registration number, date of birth and owner. The list will be made available to all exhibitors at or prior to the show.
- **ENTRY FORM:** Owners/exhibitors must complete all necessary sections on the entry form and sign the form to acknowledge acceptance of these rules and regulations, including herd health status.
- **RIBBONS & SASHES:** Ribbons and Trophies will be awarded to places from 1st to 3rd place in each class. Sashes and trophies will be awarded to the champion female, bull, steer and the supreme exhibit of the show (champion female or bull).
- **CLASS TITLES:** The winner or the championship classes will be given the title "Champion Female" or "Champion Bull". The "Champion Bull" and "Champion Female" will then compete for the title "Supreme Exhibit of the Show".
- **NLIS REQUIREMENTS:** All cattle must be NLIS compliant; they must be tagged with an approved NLIS ear tag. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to notify the NLIS database of all movements onto White Park - Scone on their own behalf.

- **DOGS:** Strictly NO Dogs.
- **CATERING:** Morning tea and lunch will be available for exhibitors and visitors on show day at their own expense.
- **STOCK FEED:** Cow hay available for purchase, please see Rodney Cooper. Entrants to supply their own feed buckets, although there are some water troughs on site you may like to bring individual water buckets.
- **WASH BAY:** available, please bring your own hose.
- **YARDS:** limited yards will be available for show cattle. If arriving in Scone before Friday afternoon, please contact Rodney Cooper for alternate place to house cattle.

ENTRIES

- Entry forms & payments can be sent by post or via email. Forms and payments to be received by the TLA Show Coordinators (Rodney & Kerry Cooper) by the closing date 6pm Friday 30th July 2021. The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure the completed forms and payments are delivered on time.
- Please include an email address with your entry form as well as proof of payment. EFT payments - Texas Longhorns Australia Inc. BSB 082 628 Account No. 823716931 stating Surname/Stud Name.
- The TLA reserves the right to cancel the show if insufficient entries are received by the closing date.
- TLA members may enter up to 3 animals per class providing each is exhibited by an experienced handler.

EXHIBITOR & HANDLER ELIGIBILITY

- All competitors & handlers must be current financial members of TLA and meet the requirements of the TLA in this document.
- Cattle must be owned by a current TLA member and the handler must be authorised by that member
- Exhibitors must certify that cattle entered under their name are their bona fide property or held by them under a written and recorded lease, at time of entry.
- Juniors wanting to compete that are not members of the TLA, Parents or Guardians will need to complete a waiver that will be available on the day and pay a small fee for insurance.

CATTLE ELIGIBILITY

- Cattle must be registered with the TLA at the date of the show (with exception of steers) are eligible to compete. Steers must have a pedigree made available to compete.
- Only cattle which are entered as exhibits are permitted entry onto the showgrounds.
- The TLA reserves the right to split a large class into 'heats' for judging
- Exhibits will enter the show in age order
- Animals will compete in one class only, with the exception of champion and supreme classes. Calves at foot of senior females do not have the opportunity to compete in the under 12 months class as a separate exhibit.
- All bulls and steers over 12 months of age must wear a permanent nose ring and heifers over 12 months must have a nose dog or permanent nose ring in for safe control.

SHOW RING RULES & ETIQUETTE

- **EXHIBITOR ATTIRE:** Exhibitors must wear 'Australian country' or 'western attire' while exhibiting cattle in the show ring. This includes clean jeans or moleskins with a long-sleeved shirt and enclosed leather boots/shoes. Ladies may wear a skirt and blouse if preferred. Caps and sports shoes are not permitted in the ring, a felt or straw hat is encouraged to be worn.
- Leather halters are also encouraged to be worn in the show ring as well as show canes held by the handler to allow an adequate presentation of the animal.

HEALTH RULES

Coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms include: -

- fever
- cough
- sore/scratchy throat and
- Shortness of breath.

If you are experiencing any of the above symptoms please do not attend the show and seek advice on isolation and testing. We will enforce COVID-19 advice at the time of the Show.

- Exhibitors must complete a National Cattle Health Statement and submit with entries to the Show Coordinator.

- Animals entered must not have been exposed to any communicable or notifiable diseases within 14 days prior to the show.

Exhibitors must not bring cattle to the show or sale if they have been exposed to or shown the signs of:

- Tuberculosis
- Enzootic Bovine Leucosis (EBL)
- Johnes Disease
- Pestivirus
- Ringworm

- Banning & removal of Infected Animals: TLA reserves the right to ban any animal from the judging ring if it is found infected, suspected to be infected with any of the above illnesses or conditions. Such animals & exhibitors may be asked to leave the showground, and will not be allowed to yard at the show venue.
- Hormones Growth Promotants (HGPs) in exhibits are prohibited

CLASS NOTES:

Entry fee: \$25.00 per animal.

Entries close: 30th July 2021

Please **read the rules and regulations carefully** to ensure agreement prior to entry.

The judging program is divided into the following classes:

Class 1: Purebred or Full Blood Heifer- up to 12 months

Class 2: Mixed Grade Heifer- up to 12 months

Class 3: Purebred or Full Blood Heifer- 12 to 24 months

Class 4: Mixed Grade Heifer- 12 to 24 months

Class 5: Purebred or full blood cow- over 24 months *

Class 6: Mixed grade cow- over 24 months *

Class 7: CHAMPION FEMALE (1st place recipients of classes 1-6 will be competing against each other for this title)

Class 8: Purebred or Full Blood Open Steer- any age. The steer that places first in this class is also awarded the title of CHAMPION STEER. (Steers do not need registration papers presented with entry fee only pedigree)

Class 9: Pure bred or full blood Bull- up to 12 months

Class 10: Pure bred or full blood Bull- 12 to 24 months

Class 11: CHAMPION BULL (1st place recipients of classes 9 & 10 will be competing against each other for this title)

Class 12: SUPREME EXHIBIT (Champion Female and Champion Bull will compete against each other for this title, steers are excluded from this title)

Class 13: BEST PRESENTED EXHIBIT

Class 14: SHOWMANSHIP AWARD

Class 15: MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR

Class 16: Junior Parader – under 21 years of age – enter on the day, nil fee

* Pee Wee – 0 to 10 years

* Intermediate – 11 to 14 years

*Senior – 15 to 21 years

All winners of the above age groups will compete for Junior Parader Trophy.

Class 17: Adult Parader – over 21 years of age – enter on the day, nil fee

Class 18: Junior Judging – under 21 years of age – enter on the day, nil fee

**Females in classes 5 & 6 are encouraged to have a calf at foot for judging. The calves will be judged alongside the female as a cow & calf unit and must be under the age of 8 months. When paying animal entry fees the calves are included in the same entry as the mother (\$25= COW + CALF AT FOOT for classes 5 & 6). Please include a photocopy of registration papers for each exhibit with their entry fee except steers- a pedigree will be needed for each steer exhibit.

Animals are eligible for a single class dependent on age, status, or gender

All animals entered in Classes 1,2,3,4,5,6,7, 9 & 10 must be TLA registered. Registration number provided below.

Animals that are sick, diseased, or intractable must not be brought to the show

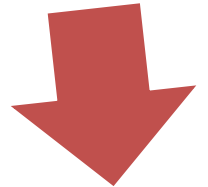
