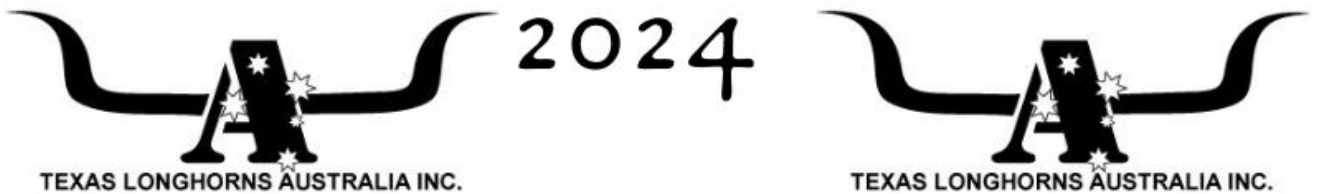

RULES & REGULATIONS OVERVIEW

GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- **JUDGING:** Judging will be based on the desirable breed characteristics developed by the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA) & International Texas Longhorn Association (ITLA) and adopted by Texas Longhorns Australia.
- **SHOW LIST:** The TLA National Show secretary will prepare and publish a list of entries including each animal by class, entry number, name, TLA registration number, date of birth and owner. The list will be available to all exhibitors at or before the show.
- **ENTRY FORM:** Owners/ exhibitors must complete all necessary sections on the entry form and sign the form to acknowledge acceptance of these rules and regulations, including herd health status.
- **RIBBONS & SASHES:** Ribbons & Trophies will be awarded to places from 1st to 3rd place in each class. Sashes and trophies will be awarded to the champion female, bull, steer, and the supreme exhibit of the show (Champion female or Bull).
- **CLASS TITLES:** The winner of the championship classes will be given the title "Champion Female" or "Champion Bull". The "Grand Champion Female" and "Grand Champion Bull" will then compete for the title "Supreme Exhibit of the show".
- **MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR:** To be awarded to the exhibitor who has the most success with their animals throughout the show. 1st place=3 points, 2nd place= 2 points, 3rd place= 1 point, Champion=5 points Supreme= 10 points
- **BEST PRESENTED EXHIBIT:** To be selected by the official judge based on how well presented the animal is including cleanliness, coat, presentation and preparation of your animal.
- **SHOWMANSHIP AWARD:** To be awarded to an exhibitor of any age who shows professionalism in presenting their cattle and themselves and handling their animals inside and outside the ring.
- **SPIRIT OF SHOW:** To the individual in the show ring who shows excellent sportsmanship and encouragement to all involved. A positive attitude and a passion for the breed and the environment.
- **NLIS REQUIREMENTS:** All cattle must be NLIS compliant and tagged with an approved NLIS ear tag. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to notify the NLIS database of all movements onto Taroom Show Grounds on their behalf.
- **PIC:** Taroom Show Grounds **QETR0733**.
- **DOGS:** Strictly NO Dogs.
- **WATER:** Please bring individual water buckets.
- **WASH BAY:** Available, please bring your hose.
- **YARDS:** Limited yards will be available for show cattle. If arriving in Taroom before Thursday afternoon, please contact Banana Shire Council.
- **CATERING:** Morning tea and lunch will be available for exhibitors and visitors at their own expense on show day.

ENTRIES:

▪ Entry forms & payments can be sent by post or via email tlashowsale@gmail.com. Forms and payments are to be received by the TLA Show Coordinator by the closing date of 6 pm Saturday 20th July 2024. The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure the completed forms and payments are delivered on time.

▪ **The TLA reserves the right to cancel the show if insufficient entries are received by the closing date.**

▪ TLA members may enter up to 3 animals per class providing each is exhibited by an experienced handler.

EXHIBITOR & HANDLER ELIGIBILITY:

- Cattle must be registered with the TLA and owned by a current TLA member, and the handler must be authorised by that member.
- Exhibitors must certify that cattle entered under their name are their bona fide property or held by them under a written and recorded lease, at the time of entry.
- Juniors wanting to compete who are not members of the TLA, Parents or Guardians may be required to complete a waiver available on the day and may be required to pay a small insurance fee.

CATTLE ELIGIBILITY:

- ✓ Cattle must be registered with the TLA at the date of the show (except for steers) and are eligible to compete. Steers must have a pedigree made available to compete and must be PB or FB.
- ✓ Only cattle that are entered in the show as exhibits are permitted entry onto the showgrounds.
- ✓ The TLA reserves the right to split a large class into 'heats' for judging. TLA reserves the right to combine classes.
- ✓ Exhibits will enter the show in age order.
- ✓ Animals will compete in one class only, except for champion and supreme classes and breeder/progeny groups.
- ✓ Calves at the foot of senior females **do not** have the opportunity to compete in the under 12 months class as a separate exhibit.
- ✓ All bulls over 12 months of age must wear a permanent nose ring and heifers and steers over 12 months must have a nose dog/clip in for safe control.

SHOW RING RULES & ETIQUETTE:

- ◆ **EXHIBITOR ATTIRE:** Exhibitors must wear 'Australian country' or 'Western attire' while exhibiting cattle in the show ring. This includes clean jeans or moleskins with a long-sleeved shirt and enclosed leather boots/shoes. Ladies may wear a skirt and blouse if preferred. Caps and sports shoes are not permitted in the ring, a felt or straw hat is encouraged to be worn.
- ◆ **HALTERS:** Leather halters are also encouraged to be worn in the show ring as well as show canes held by the handler to allow an adequate presentation of the animal.

HEALTH RULES:

Coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms include: -

- Fever
- Cough
- Sore/scratchy throat and Shortness of breath.

If you are experiencing any of the above symptoms, please do not attend the show and seek advice on isolation and testing. We will enforce COVID-19 advice at the time of the Show.

- Exhibitors must complete a National Cattle Health Statement and submit it with entries to the show coordinator.
- Hormones Growth Promotants (HGPs) in exhibits are prohibited.
- Animals entered must not have been exposed to any communicable or notifiable diseases within 14 days before the show.
- Exhibitors must not bring cattle to the show or sale if they have been exposed to or shown the signs of:
 - Tuberculosis
 - Enzootic Bovine Leucosis (EBL) -Johnes Disease -Pestivirus
 - Ringworm
- Banning & Removal of Infected Animals: TLA reserves the right to ban any animal from the judging ring if it is found infected or suspected to be infected with any of the above illnesses or conditions. Such animals & exhibitors may be asked to leave the showground and will not be allowed to yard at the show venue.

Please include a photocopy of registration papers for each exhibit with their entry fee. Steers are not required to be registered; however, a pedigree is required for each steer exhibit. **The committee reserves the right to combine or split classes wherever deemed necessary.**

The judging program

is divided into the following classes:

Class 1: Heifer Under 12 Months.

Class 2: Heifer 12 & Under 15 Months.

Class 3: Heifer 15 & Under 18 Months.

Class 4: Heifer 18 & Under 21 Months.

National Junior Champion Heifer *Winners of classes 1,2,3 & 4 compete for this title.*

Class 5: Cow 21 & Under 24 Months.

Class 6: Cow 24 & Under 30 Months.

Class 7: Cow 30 Months & Over.

National Senior Champion Cow *Winners of classes 5, 6 & 7 compete for this title.*

National Grand Champion Female 2024 *Winners of Junior & Senior Champion compete for this title.*

Class 8: Purebred or Fullblood Bull Under 12 Months.

Class 9: Purebred or Fullblood Bull 12 & Under 15 Months.

National Junior Champion Bull *Winners of classes 8 & 9 compete for this title.*

Class 10: Purebred or Fullblood Bull 15 Under 21 Months.

Class 11: Purebred or Fullblood Bull 21 & Under 24 Months.

National Senior Champion Bull *Winners of classes 10 & 11 compete for this title.*

National Grand Champion Bull 2024 *Winners of Junior & Senior Champion Bull compete for this title.*

Supreme Exhibit 2024 *Grand Champion Female & Bull compete for this title.*

Class 12: Purebred or Fullblood Steer Under 12 Months.

Class 13: Purebred or Fullblood Steer 12 & Under 24 Months.

Class 14: Purebred or Fullblood Steer 24 & Under 48 Months.

Class 15: Purebred or Fullblood Steer Over 48 Months.

National Grand Champion Steer 2024 *Winners of classes 12, 13, 14 & 15 compete for this title.*

Class 16: Breeders Group

Class 17: Sire/Dam Progeny

Class 18: Junior Parader Competition. Enter on the day, Free Nomination.

Pee Wee: Under 10 years

Intermediate: 11 under 15 years

Senior: 15 under 21 years

National Champion Junior Parader 2024 *Winners of Pee Wee, Intermediate & Senior classes will compete for this title.*

Class 19: Open Parader Competition 2024

21 Years & Over. Enter on the day, Free Nomination.

Class 20: Junior Stud Judging Competition, Under 21 years. Enter on the day, Free Nomination.
