



Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale Guidelines

1. All cattle vendors at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be current financial members of Texas Longhorns Australia.
2. All animals sold through the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be registered with Texas Longhorns Australia, with the exception of steers (See Point 3).
3. If not registered, All steers sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be eligible for registration and be the progeny of two Texas Longhorns Australia registered parents.
4. Cross Bred Animals are not permitted to be sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale.
5. All animals sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must meet the breed standard.
6. All animals sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be free of disease.
7. All animals sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be tractable and of good temperament.
8. All animals sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be sound and suitable for breeding unless otherwise clearly stated in the listing, for example steers or a freemartin heifer resulting from a twin birth.
9. It is the responsibility of the vendor to provide multiple good quality photos and video footage of the nominated animals.
10. It is recommended but not required that pregnant animals be accompanied by a vet certificate.
11. It is recommended but not required that bulls be appropriately semen tested before sale.
12. Sale nominations of Bulls over the age of 5 Years at the time of sale will not be accepted, to ensure genetic diversity remains a priority.
13. All animals sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be branded and NLIS Tagged PRIOR to sale.
14. All animals sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale must be accompanied by the appropriate paperwork, including National Vendor Declaration.
15. It is the responsibility of the Vendor, upon request of the Purchasers, to lodge and pay for the transfers of all animals sold at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale to Purchasers who are TLA Members at the time of the National Sale.
16. The Texas Longhorns Australia Committee reserve the right to withdraw any animal they deem unsuitable for sale.
17. Whilst all care is taken to ensure accurate listings, Texas Longhorns Australia Inc & the Texas Longhorns Australia committee have No Responsibility for the animals sold or purchased at the Texas Longhorns Australia National Sale.
